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REPORT ON REVIEW OF INTERIM CONDENSED CONSOLIDATED FINANCIAL INFORMATION TO THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF AREF ENERGY HOLDING COMPANY K.S.C. (CLOSED)

Introduction

We have reviewed the accompanying interim condensed consolidated statement of financial position of Aref Energy Holding Company K.S.C. (Closed) ("the company") and its subsidiaries ("the group") as at 30 June 2009 and the related interim condensed consolidated income statement and interim condensed consolidated statement of comprehensive income for the three month and six month periods then ended and the related interim condensed consolidated statement of cash flows and interim condensed consolidated statement of changes in equity for the six month period then ended. A review is substantially less in scope than an audit conducted in accordance with International Standards on Auditing and consequently does not enable us to obtain assurance that we would become aware of all significant matters that might be identified in an audit. Accordingly, we do not express an audit opinion.

Conclusion

Based on our review, nothing has come to our attention that causes us to believe that the accompanying interim condensed consolidated financial information are not prepared, in all material respects, in accordance with IAS 34.

Report on other Legal and Regulatory Requirements

Furthermore, based on our review, the interim condensed consolidated financial information is in agreement with the books of account of the company. We further report that, to the best of our knowledge and belief, no violations of the Commercial Companies' Law of 1960, as amended, nor of the Articles of Association of the company have occurred during the six month period then ended 30 June 2009 that might have had a material effect on the business of the company or on its financial position.


